The Gateway has 3 Carnforth shops, add their value, divide by The Snug. What shop is answer?	The station was opened in 1846, about the same time as the iron works.
It was completely rebuilt in 1937. In 1945 Brief Encounter was filmed at night here.	10. Come out of the car park and find a safe place to cross the road.	11. What was the former ladies name of the Co-op?	12. What is the sum of the digits on the fire station?
